



COVID-19 Prevention Policies

We are excited to return to dance classes in the studio, and can assure you that we have restructured our schedule and facility to comply with COVID-19 prevention and precaution guidelines. This document lists the steps being taken so we can safely return to in-person dance classes.

<p>Overall Facility</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Upon entry into the studio, lockers will be available or other designated area for street shoes, dance bags, etc. • Most tables, chairs, couches, and porous materials throughout the facility have been removed. • Lost and found will be eliminated during this time. • Water coolers and the coffee machine will not be available at this time. • Dancers should bring their own filled water bottles (water or Gatorade only). • No food allowed in the facility during this time. • Class times have been staggered to allow for only one class to occupy a dance area at a time, and minimize the number of students in a space. • Teachers will supply markers to indicate where dancers will stand to achieve/maintain social distancing between dancers.
<p>Rehearsal Space and Restroom</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dancers and all employees are required to wash hands upon entry into the studio. • Sanitizer is available throughout the facility, and dancers/teachers are required to use sanitizer upon exit of the dance studio rooms. • All ballet barres, door knobs, light switches and other “high touch” areas will be wiped down and disinfected after each class. • Deep cleaning/disinfecting will occur before the studio opens, and after the studio closes for the day. • Restrooms and lobby will be cleaned and disinfected after every class/age group (and more frequently, if needed) using EPA-registered/CDC-approved disinfectants, with close attention paid to high-touch surfaces such as faucets, toilets, etc. • Rehearsal spaces within the facility will be sectioned off with a designated entrance/exit space.
<p>Mayne Attraction Staff</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All employees will receive information on COVID-19 prevention. • Employees will take their temperature and perform a self-assessment prior to arrival at the studio and not report to work if they are ill or exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19. • Facial coverings / masks will be required for all employees.

<p style="text-align: center;">Mayne Attraction Staff, continued</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ms. Sharmayne/admin staff will meet their dancers at the door for each class, and the instructor and all students will be required to wash their hands prior to heading into the classroom. • Instructors will take attendance for each class, and log the information in the attendance system to ensure easy access to information for potential contact tracing if needed.
<p style="text-align: center;">Dancers & Families</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Until further notice, we will close registration/enrollment in classes once they have reached 10 dancers. Enrollment will be completed on a first come, first served basis (waitlist enacted thereafter). • Please do not arrive more than 10 min prior to class. • Students/Parents must conduct a self-assessment and not enter the studio if exhibiting symptoms of any sickness, have a fever of 100.4 or higher or have been exposed to those suspected of having COVID-19. • We will screen for temperature upon arrival and anyone with a temperature higher than 100.4 will not be permitted to dance and sent home. These individuals must remain fever free for 48 hours, without fever reducing medication, before returning to the studio. We also will ask if there has been exposure to COVID-19 and/or experiencing symptoms. • Dancers/Parents should wear facial coverings/masks when they enter the studio and while preparing for class. Dancers are required to wear face masks in the lobby, and during class if social distancing is not possible (small class space). • Please arrive already dressed in dance clothes (but dance shoes should not be worn outside). Dancers can change into dance shoes upon entering the studio. • Each dancer should bring their own filled water bottle. • Each dancer should bring their own small hand towel to use for the ballet barres. We will be disinfecting the barres after each class uses them, however this is an additional layer of protection. • Mrs. Sharmayne/admin staff will meet their students at the door, and escort them to their rehearsal space. • We ask that parents drop off their child and wait in the car or come back and pick up their child after the class is over. At the end of class, dancers will be dismissed one at a time to their cubbies, put on their masks, and get their dance bag. <i>(Parents please be on time for pick up, as this allows teachers and staff ample time to clean before the next class).</i> • If a parent must stay with their young child, we ask that only 1 parent stay; however the preference is to limit any gathering in the studio besides the dancers and instructors.
